

Q: What kind of 1099's does MRI print?

A: MRI prints forms 1099-NEC and 1099-MISC.

Q: What fields can MRI print amounts in?

A: We print amounts in field 1 on 1099-NEC. On form 1099-MISC, we print in field 10 if the vendor is setup as an attorney fees vendor. It will print in Box 1 of 1099-MISC if the vendor is marked as a Property Payee. Note that this refers gross proceeds paid to an attorney. Amounts for regular services provided by an attorney should be reported on form 1099-NEC.

Q: Can I change the amount that will print for a vendor?

A: Yes, you can manually change the amount that will print for a vendor by using the 1099 Worksheet process.

Q: Are there any 1099 updates this year and if so, for what versions?

A: There are updates for 1099s in version X5.10.13. 1099 payers only issue by setting under additional access in security console.

- Fixed IR 122831 - 1099 NEC and MISC will not generate if payer without an e-payer record is included.
- Fixed IR 119762 - Vendors added via 1099 worksheet are not included on the Preview List.
- Fixed IR 119568 - Unable to view/edit entities mapped to a 1099 PAYER with an apostrophe.
- Fixed IR115085 - MRI_1099NEC truncates recipient's addresses.
- Fixed IR 111738 - Unable to correct FedIDs on 1099 e-payers (T_199A) in web.

Q: Are there any 1099 set up changes?

A: The IRS has changed the threshold for electronic reporting from 250 forms per payer to 10. This means that any payer that has more than 10 1099s will need to reported electronically requiring the set up of a transmitter record and an e-payer record for each payer that needs to report electronically.

Q: Is there an easy way to see who has been paid during the 2022 1099 reporting period and whether all setup items such as account 1099 reporting status, vendor 1099 required status, and entity/payer ID association?

A: Running the query below will show all vendors with checks dated between 1/1/2023 and 12/31/2023. It will also show if the account(s) used for the vendor are marked as 1099 account, if the vendor is marked as requiring a 1099 and if the entity that paid the vendor has been associated with a 1099 payer ID.
